**ACTS 2:1-21 PENTECOST**

- Welcome/icebreaker** Describe an experience of someone coming unexpectedly. How did you feel?!
- Worship** Breathe on me Breath of God (tune: Carlisle), Spirit of the Living God, Holy Spirit we welcome You, Jesus be the centre.
- Word (verses):**  
v. 1 ("all together in one place") The early church were constantly in prayer before Pentecost (1:14). How can we improve our prayer lives individually and corporately?  
What might be the results?
- 2- What might the manifestations of the Spirit teach us and what would happen if the Spirit came like this in our services?
- 14- Peter was answering a question based upon what the people of Jerusalem saw the early Christians doing. What conclusions might the people of the Strettons draw about what they see in us?
- 17, 21 How can we enable the Spirit to be poured upon us (see also v. 36-38)?
- 17-21, 36-38 What will be the results?
- Wind/prayer** Ask the Holy Spirit to come as on the Day of Pentecost!
- Works/witness** Seek to walk in the Spirit, co-operating with Him!
